What's been happening in November?

Local group Rosenlund Contractors Pty Ltd is continuing with the demolition of the former Toombul Shopping Centre. The demolition works are expected to complete in early 2025, depending on weather and progress.

In November, Rosenlund Contractors has undertaken the following works:

- Ongoing removal of the centre's structure, ground floor slab and inground structures and services; over 90% of the ground floor slab has now been cleared
- Ongoing removal of demolished material from site by haulage trucks
- In late November, works will commence to replace the strip of land immediately adjoining the Kedron Brook cycle path with grass

What's planned for December?

In December, the contractor will:

- Continue to remove the remaining ground floor slab and inground structures and services
- Continue to remove asphalt from the main car park area
- Continue with the removal of demolished material from site by haulage trucks
- Commence preparing the sediment basins to protect Kedron Brook from sediment
- Commence relocating sections of the boundary fence



What you might see

Various specialist machinery will be used including:

- Standard excavators
- Long reach excavators
- Bobcats
- Haulage trucks

Works will take place during Brisbane City Council's standard building work hours:



**Between 6.30am and 6.30pm,
Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.**

If, from time-to-time, activities need to take place outside of these hours, we will notify near neighbours in advance.
